

# activity ideas

Here are some activity ideas to do with your kids and grow their faith if you are confined to your home. Need more ideas? Watch Tangled - Rapunzel has lots of ideas of things you can do!

1. Spend 30 minutes a day learning a new topic. Research ideas can be, what Jesus would have eaten? What would a day have looked like in Bible times?
2. Face time! Pick a person to speak with and give them a call. Ask how you can be praying for that person.
3. Pick a Bible story, and then use Lego to build it out as you read it. Great examples can be the walls of Jericho falling down, building of the temple, the sermon on the mount, Egypt at the time of Moses.
4. Explore God's underwater creation! There are live webcams set up of sea creatures at Georgia Aquarium.

9. Draw a self portrait. This can be done with crayons, but even better with things like buttons, pasta, and things from the junk drawer. You can tie this in to speak on how God made each one of us unique.


